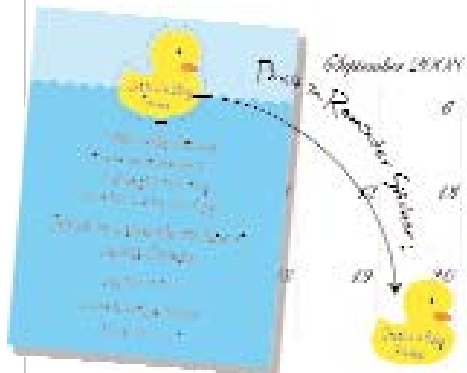
Check It Out
